Between churches and evangelical outreaches, Pastor Roy Jacob oversees 25 ministries. He also administers a children's home in Tuticorin. These ministries are separated by a bus ride that takes as much as twelve hours. Roy has twenty workers on staff for all the ministries and four in the children's home.

Afghanistan:

Chris and Megan LeMaster were sent to Afghanistan by Fellowship in 2009. The LeMasters are bringing the love of Jesus to a mostly Muslim and war-torn country.

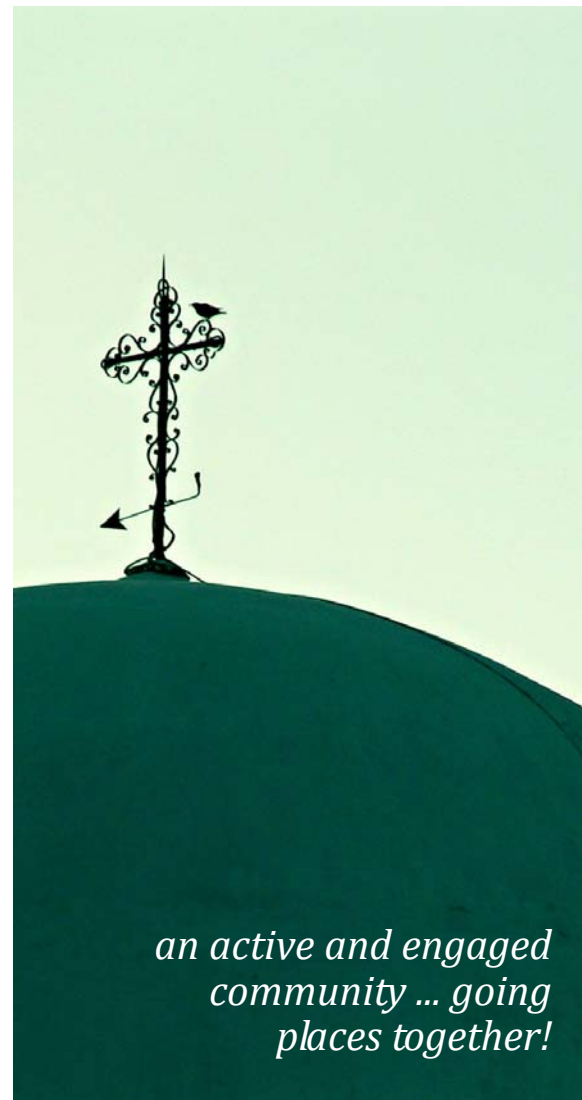
Fellowship also supports and encourages short-term mission trips. Opportunities for trips will be published in the bulletin.

Fellowship works to cultivate, send, and support short-term and long-term missionaries and to partner with the work of indigenous ministries throughout the world.

Russia Ministry:

Fellowship supports and is the USA home to Russians Reaching Russians, an international church-planting ministry focused on Russia. Working with RRR Russian Administrator, Denis Kozlov, and key Russian pastors, Fellowship helps to train pastors and plant new churches. Since the Iron Curtain fell in the early 1990s, RRR has helped start over 40 churches in Russia since it’s start in the early 90’s as the Iron Curtain fell. RRR also has helped start significant prison, foster-care, and drug rehabilitation ministries in Russia where the love of God has changed tens of thousands of lives.

Fellowship also has a partner relationship in Russia with Pastor Andrei Ziablitsev and his Torch of Faith Church in Kommunar, Russia.



Philippines & Asia Ministry:

Fellowship is partnering with Stephanie Uy and a leadership team of Filipino and Chinese Christians based in the Philippines. Together, they have trained thousands who have trained thousands of Filipino pastors to disciple young believers one on one with the First Steps materials developed at Fellowship. With a strong base in the Philippines, this work is now spreading into China, Cambodia, and Vietnam.

Ces Garcia is the First Steps director in the Northern Lausanne area of the Philippines. Ces travels into remote and mountainous areas to reach villages with the First Steps ministry, and, as a result, many are being discipled.

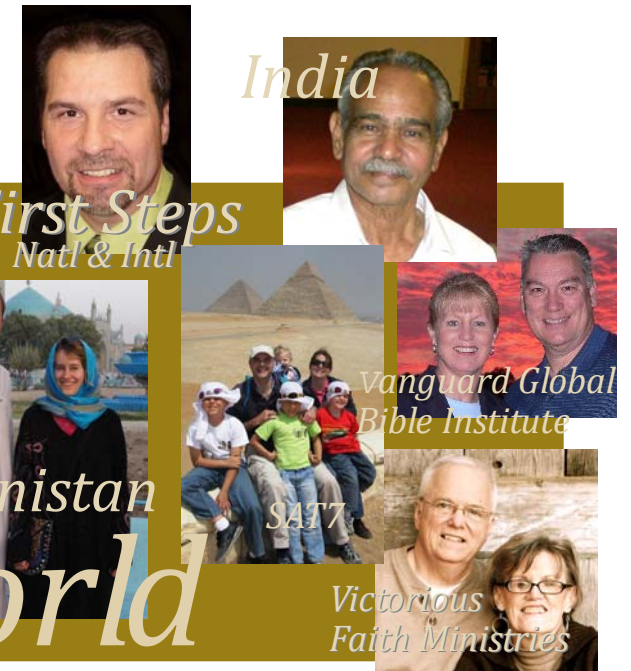
